SO GREAT A SALVATION, PT. 25

Main Text: (Hebrews 12:12-17)

Supporting Text:

- (Isaiah 35:5) Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, and the ears of the deaf shall be unstopped (6) Then shall the lame man leap as an hart, and the tongue of the dumb sing, for in the wilderness shall waters break out, and streams in the dessert.
- (**Proverbs 4:25**) Let thine eyes look right on, and let thine eyelids look straight before thee. **(26)** Ponder the path of thy feet, and let all thy ways be established. **(27)** Turn not to the right hand nor to the left: remove thy foot from evil.
- (**Proverbs 14:12**) There is a way which seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death.
- (Matthew 5:9) Blessed are the peacemakers: for they shall be called the children of God.
- (1 Peter 3:8) Finally, be ye all of one mind, having compassion one of another, love as brethren, be pitiful, be courteous: (9) Not rendering evil for evil, or railing for railing: but contrariwise blessing; knowing that ye are thereunto called, that ye should inherit a blessing (10) For he that will love life, and see good days, let him refrain his tongue from evil, and his lips that they speak no guile: (11) Let him eschew evil, and do good; let him seek peace, and ensue it.
- (Ephesians 2:14) For he is our peace, who hath made both one, and hath broken down the middle wall of partition between us;
- (**Titus 3:2**) To speak evil of no man, to be no brawlers, but gentle, shewing all meekness unto all men. (3) For we ourselves also were sometimes foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving divers lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful, and hating one another.
- (**Titus 2:11**) For the grace of God that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men, **(12)** Teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly, in this present world;
- (Eph 4:30) And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption. (31) Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice:
