

HOW TO BECOME A CHRISTIAN

Jesus Christ, the Son of God, died for us and rose from the dead, making salvation available as a gift (John 3:16; Romans 6:23). In order to benefit from this great sacrificial love, one must receive God's grace through faith in Christ and obedience to him (Romans 5:1-2; Hebrews 5:9). To become a Christian, the Bible teaches that we must believe in and put our trust in Christ (John 8:24), turn away from a life of sin (Luke 13:3), confess Jesus as Lord (Romans 10:9-10), and be baptized for the forgiveness of sins (Acts 2:38; 22:16). FROM FAITH TO FAITH PT. 4

Main Text: Romans 2:1-16

Supporting Text:

- (Matthew 3:8) Bring forth therefore fruits meet for repentance: (9) And think not to say within yourselves, We have Abraham to our father:
- (Romans 1:18) For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men.
- (Micah 3:11) The heads thereof judge for reward, and the priests thereof teach for hire, and the prophets thereof divine for money: yet will they lean upon the Lord, and say, Is not the Lord among us? none evil can come upon us.
- (Isaiah 6:5) Woe is me! for I am undone; because I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips.
- (Amos 5:18) Woe unto you that desire the day of the Lord! to what end is it for you? the day of the Lord is darkness, and not light.
- (Acts 10:34) Of a truth I perceive that God is no respecter of persons:
- (James 2:1) My brethren, have not the faith of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Lord of glory, with respect of persons.
- (Colossians 3:23) And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men; (24) Knowing that of the Lord ye shall receive the reward of the inheritance: for ye serve the Lord Christ. (25) But he that doeth wrong shall receive for the wrong which he hath done: and there is no respect of persons.
- (Matthew 5:3) Blessed are the poor in spirit: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
- (Matthew 5:4) Blessed are they that mourn: for they shall be comforted.
- (James 1:22) But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.(23) For if any be a hearer of the word, and not a doer, he is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a glass: (24) For he beholdeth himself, and goeth his way, and straightway forgetteth what manner of man he was.
- (**Genesis 26:10**) And Abimelech said, What is this thou hast done unto us? one of the people might lightly have lien with thy wife, and thou shouldest have brought guiltiness upon us.
