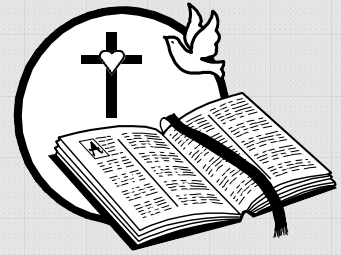

I've recently returned to the United States after spending another 6 months teaching the Bible in China. Thanks to your help, I was able to spend time each week helping a group of young Chinese people learn more about Christ. I am currently enrolled in a graduate program in counseling and plan to finish within 2 years. While I was in China this past semester, I worked with my good Chinese friend Ge Bing. While he still has a long way to go, he is very interested in learning the Bible and hopefully will continue reading with another missionary in our town. I also worked with two new students, Peter Zhu and Pei Lin. Both are interested in Christ, and approached me to learn more. Though I am back in the States currently, I hope to be able to return to China for perhaps another year or two when I finish my degree. I could not have done it without your help, and so I want to express my gratitude for your willingness to participate in the Lord's work with me.
