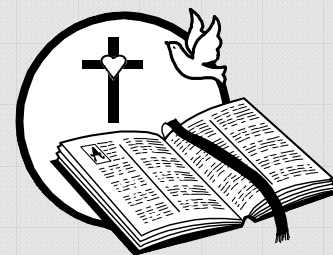

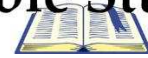
EGG HUNT
