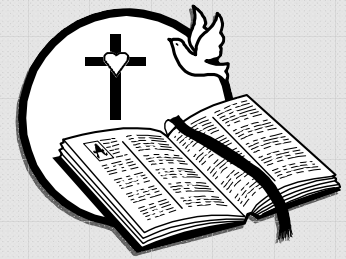

HOW TO BECOME A CHRISTIAN
